DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

It is a requirement that East Preston Men In Sheds holds a member's name, home address, email address and phone number(s) in order to administrate membership procedures.

Under the new legislation called "General Data Protection Regulation" (GDPR), it is mandatory that new members opt-in to allow these records to be retained by the SHED.

When taking up your membership, YES / NO permission options have been incorporated into this adjoining Form. The new legislation requires that you consent to opt-in (or not) on having your information maintained by the SHED.

The SHED Secretary holds all the names, home addresses, email addresses and phone numbers of its members for communication purposes and membership renewal management. Occasionally, the membership list is issued to paid-up members for group-member communication use. This data will never be shared with anyone outside the SHED membership and will never be used for any other purpose by the SHED's officers.
